## PRAY A LOT IN THE SPIRIT

***“Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints” - Eph 6:18***

There are different kinds of prayers. For instances 1 Timothy 2:1 highlights, ***“I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men”***. Listed in this verse are different kinds of prayers you must know and pray. Moved by the Spirit, Apostle Paul in our theme scripture lets us know that with all kinds of prayers, we have to pray in the Spirit. He says, ***“Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints”***. This show that in whatever kind of prayer, you must prioritize praying in the spirit. Praying in the spirit here refers to praying in other tongues or strange tongues whose utterance is of the Spirit. This tells you the importance of praying in other tongues. This tells you that whether it is giving of thanks or intercessory prayer, there must be significant praying in tongues. In this way the prayer in your understanding (in the language you know) gets more perfectly aligned to God’s will. You are able to get the right words of expression through your mind. In 1 Corinthians 14:15 the Spirit enlightens us through Paul, ***“What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also”***. He emphasizes that praying with the spirit should have preeminence over your understanding. Praying in the Spirit and with the spirit (the human spirit) is one and the same thing, though “praying in the Spirit or Holy Ghost” broadly means praying the Holy Spirit inspired and guided prayer.

## NOT ASHAMED OF THE GOSPEL

***“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek”.- Romans 1:16***

Our opening scripture encapsulate the passionate heart that Apostle Paul had as regards to the Gospel of our Lord Jesus. Without such unapologetic commitment, the Gospel wouldn't have reached you today. That is the same attitude God wants you to have. Apostle Paul run his race, now it is your time and turn. If you have the understanding that Paul had concerning the Gospel, you can have remarkable results as he achieved, because God is no respecter of people. He understood that the Gospel is God's power for the salvation of every person who believes. He knew something that would save man and he refused to be silent on it. The Gospel is the only way through which man gets saved. The Lord declared about Himself in John14:6, ***“I am the way, truth and life. No man comes to the Father except by me”***. This was an absolute communication. Man can't have fellowship with God except through Jesus Christ. The Gospel is about Jesus Christ and what He came to do in the earth and what has resulted from that work. Jesus knew that He held the key to man's salvation and He was willing to face that shameful death of a criminal in our place. He despised shame. You too, never be ashamed of that which will save people. Witness about the Lord Jesus without fear. He gave us the Holy Spirit to help us and strengthen us so that we don't do His work with human energy and ability. Be unashamed and bold to identify with Him that died for the whole world.

## THE SWORD OF THE SPIRIT

In our last study we looked at the belt of truth part of the armour which is the word of God. In our theme scripture today, we are given another part which is the sword of the spirit. He reveals that the sword is the word of God. What is the difference with the belt truth which was the first mentioned element of the armory? In John 17:17 the term word is translated from a Greek word *logos* which the whole embodiment of the God's revelation given to us. In Ephesians 6:17, the same word is translated from a Greek word *rhēma* which means the spoken word. The sword of the Spirit therefore deals with the word of God being spoken or declared. So we don't just keep truth in our hearts but we have to speak truth. Truth spoken is a sword of the Spirit. This means when we declare God's word, we are actually on the offensive or attacking operation in the warfare. This dismantles satanic schemes and plans. Revelation 19:15 declares ***“And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God”***. This is how the Lord will smite the nations at His second coming, by the word of His mouth. This is what He wants us to do in reigning over all forces of darkness in our day. God's word in our mouth is a sword of the spirit executing judgments over evil. Have the word in your heart and in your mouth. Psalm 2:2 talks about declaring the decree. The decree is what God has said and you are supposed to make declaration based on that. That is the sword of the Spirit.

Dear Father, your word is in my heart and in my mouth as truth and a sword of the spirit. I speak forth your word and satanic schemes are scattered over the nations. **1:6**

There are two important callings common to every child of God, which are the calling of a king and that of a priest. That is what our theme scriptures conveys. It says, ***“And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever”***. He doesn't say He will make us as in referring to the future. This is what we are in Christ. 1 Peter 2:9 calls us the royal priesthood. That means a kingdom of priests. It is vital to understand these callings for your effectiveness. As a priest of God, your function is to offer spiritual sacrifices to God. 1 Peter 2:5 tells us, ***“Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ”***. These sacrifices are largely in our praise and prayers to God. Additionally it also covers our giving and instructing others in the word of God. As a king you reign, enforcing the rule of God's kingdom in the earth. Romans 5:17 says, ***“For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ”***. As a king you make declaration on basis of God's decrees in the word. You speak forth God's word in the earth thereby bringing to bear God's will in the nations. That is the responsibility of a king. You ensure that there is order. You judge any disorder in the spirit with your decrees of God's justice. In this you are authorized by God to use the name of Jesus which the most powerful seal of approval. God's word (which encapsulates His will) is settled forever in heaven (Psalm 119:89). But now it is your responsibility as a king to have it established in the earth and in your life.

There is no retirement in praising God. Your life of praise is not conditioned to your circumstances. Don’t allow whatever happens to you extinguish the fire of praise on the altar of your heart towards the Lord. Hebrews 13:15 AMPC enjoins us, ***“Through Him, therefore, let us constantly and at all times offer up to God a sacrifice of praise, which is the fruit of lips that thankfully acknowledge and confess and glorify His name.” Let your heart always burn with praises to God. God instructed the priests, “the fire on the altar shall be kept burning on it; it shall not go out to” (Leviticus 6:12).*** Now your heart is His altar and never allow praise to cease.

This is your New Testament role as God’s priest to offer spiritual sacrifices of praise to God. Be active in this responsibility of rendering the calves of your lips with grateful hearts. Hallelujah
